

June 11, 2020: Logistics and Supply Chain webinar was conducted to discuss the affect of lockdown. The halt in transportation has led to havoc loss in the economy of the world and protecting ourselves from pandemic through social distancing, hand sanitizing, and mask seem to be the only option.

The speakers quoted few insights of the present scenario during the webinar which includes:

- Shifting towards digitalization
- Purchase of materials through portal
- 2. Confirmation of logistics through portal
- 4. Work from home with digital technologies

- Strongly following Atmanirbharta Most of the workers will reskill themselves and avoid going to cities
- 7. The main source for revenue generation will be from rural villages
- Government will invest maximum funds in rural areas which include agriculture, small industries and MSME.
- Supply chain will be dependable on regional suppliers and regional logistics
- Factories will support supply chain with immediate funds or reserve liquidity
- 11. Flexible and adaptable supply chain

- 14. As government will focus on rural industries, Mahua flower from Odisha may be one of the resources for liquor, fragrance production, oil distillation.
- 15. Fish cultivation and dry fish exporting will be one of the prime business in Odisha.
- 16. Fish markets will choose cycle while vegetables, paddy rice, may use bullock carts, cycle van, rickshaw as their logistics for the wholesale and retail markets.
- 17. MSME and small scale industries may start selling directly to retail markets or may use village logistics.


